The church history specialization will first lead you through an exploration of the early church fathers and Greek apologists. The following divisions in the church and doctrinal construction will also be studied through the Middle Ages, the Reformation Period, and the Modern Era.

Learning about the key church figures and the movements that contributed to the spread of Christianity into the New World will be an integral part of your studies. You'll explore the history, major personalities, background, and beliefs of Evangelicalism, as well as its rise in America from the 20th century through the current day. Studying Evangelicalism from its beginnings to the modern day will allow you to better understand the present state of Christianity in the nation.

 A study of religious movement characterized by the advocacy of strict conformity to sacred texts.

Graduation Requirements
